PURPOSE of Trip

The purpose of the sponsor trip is both to raise money for investment & growth of additional companies in Kenya, and to engage additional expertise from Dutch business people to help uncover the best opportunities for job creation in Kenya.

You may participate in this trip as sponsor or participant. Funds raised will be directed to the best local job creation opportunities as selected by trip participants. Post-investment information will be provided to all on a quarterly basis.

Cost & Sponsor Details

To ensure good use of funds for investment in job creation opportunities, a minimum of $\[\]$ 5.000,- is required from sponsorships or own contribution.

Participants arrange their own flight to Nairobi, but local hotel, meals & transportation are paid by CBA, in exchange for your participation and help.
